

The Oakfield Corners Dairy team is excited to host the 2021 Growing Through Showing Workshop. In addition to including tips and tricks for the show ring, we will feature technology and real-world learning experiences on the farm. The program is open to 4-H/FFA/breed association youth of all experience levels, and participants will be grouped according to skill level. All students will tour the new robotic rotary milking system at the farm and participate in dairy promotions/public relations, as well as three break-out sessions. To allow for a more customized experience, rank sessions from 1-6 in order of preference, and we will do our best to accommodate your selections.

Due to the ongoing Covid pandemic, we ask that all attendees wear masks during sessions that are held indoors and respect social distancing guidelines. We will have varying start times throughout the day to allow for smaller groups and fewer people on farm. Please rank your start time and break-out session preferences, with a rank of "1" being the most preferred.

We are pleased to offer the workshop, souvenir T-shirt, and lunch for a minimal reservation fee of \$5 per youth attendee. Parents/ leaders may accompany students during the workshop. Please note the number of adults that will be in attendance and include \$5/adult to cover the cost of lunch. Registrations will be accepted until June 5, or until a maximum of 200 youth participants are enrolled.
